5. Written Essay

**HISTORY OF BOGGS ACADEMY, THE BOGGS ACADEMY NATIONAL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION (BANAA) AND OUR SCHOLARSHIP (BANAS)**

Boggs Academy was a Christian co-educational college preparatory boarding school founded in 1906 in Keysville, Georgia by Reverend Dr. John L. Phelps. After its founding the school came under the auspices of the Board of National Missions of the Presbyterian Church, USA. The school was named for Miss Virginia P. Boggs who helped to secure contributions toward its land and erection. The school closed in 1986 after 80 years of operations and is being leased by a private organization for community service activities.

The BANAA is committed to continuing the legacy of this great institution. In 2006, The BANAS was established for the purpose of awarding scholarships to family members of the BANAA membership. Through these awards it is our intention to grow the legacy. As each recipient graduates and goes out into the world, it is our hope and belief that they will continue to exemplify and illuminate the prestigious standards and ideals reflected through the Boggs Academy education.

The first BANAS Scholarship will be awarded in 2012. All applicants for scholarship must be a graduating high school senior or an undergraduate or graduate student, who has been accepted to or is currently attending an accredited college or university. Additionally they must be a descendant or relative of a Boggs Academy graduate or associate member of the BANAA. Part-time students will be considered. The scholarship application deadline is February 20, 2012.

**MEMBERSHIP:** The BANAA is an organization dedicated to creating opportunity for their descendants to continue the legacy of academic and social excellence synonymous with Boggs Academy College Preparatory School. **Recipients of BANAS are encouraged to give back by supporting the association's scholarship fund upon completion of their studies.**

**REAPPLICATION:** Those who have previously applied are encouraged to apply again. It is the intention of the association to award scholarships each year to those deserving students who have proven themselves to be strong worthy candidates.

**Winners: The Scholarship Committee reviews all applications and selects the scholarship winner(s). Winners will be notified of the selection by electronic and certified snail mail. All decisions made by this committee are final.**

**STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING**

**By accepting this award the recipient is agreeing to the following conditions governing this scholarship:**

The recipient will:

1. Strive to maintain a 3.0 grade point average.
2. Remain in good standing with the college or institution by remaining a person of high moral character and continuously demonstrate characteristics synonymous with the Boggs Academy legacy.
3. Understand that BANAA reserves the right to use the name and/or photograph of the recipient in promotional materials designed to increase awareness of the scholarship fund and when advertising fund raising events for the scholarship program.
4. Understand that this scholarship is a privilege and not a right. As a privilege it may be revoked, withdrawn or terminated by the scholarship and executive committee in the event that the recipient does not comply with its intent and purpose.
5. The Scholarship committee and the Executive committee truly expect that the recipient will make their family, friends, proud of their achievements.
6. BANAA Rights-The BANAA reserves the right to use the name and/or photograph of scholarship award recipients in promotional materials designed to increase awareness of the Scholarship Fund, and when soliciting funding or advertise fund raising events for the Scholarship Fund. By accepting scholarship awards, recipients understand their college, university or educational institution as well as the BANAA, may request confirmation of scholarship awards from one another in connection with institutional financial aid matters.
7. Scholarship Privilege - As a privilege it may be revoked or withdrawn or terminated by the Scholarship and Executive Committee in the event that the recipient does not comply with the intent and purpose of the Scholarship. The scholarship will be placed under review if the facts and circumstances of the recipient's performance, whether scholastic or otherwise, does not follow the Administrative Rules and Procedural Guidelines stated in this document.
8. The Scholarship is a privilege and not a right. The recipient is expected to remain a person of high moral character, and continuously demonstrate leadership, professionalism and other characteristics synonymous with the Boggs Academy legacy. The truly expect that the recipient will make their family, and friends, proud of their achievements
9. Communication – The Scholarship committee remains interested in following the recipient's accomplishments and endeavors during the Scholarship period. Therefore the recipient is encouraged to communicate regularly with the Scholarship committee regarding his or her post secondary progress. *(Two committee members will be assigned to this task.)* The recipient is also encouraged to share any specific problems encountered with the scholarship process so that the committee can assist in any way possible. Our intent is to remedy problems immediately so that the Scholarship recipient remains in good standing.

Giving back to the BANAA- the Boggs Academy National Alumni Association is an organization dedicated to creating opportunity for their descendants to continue the legacy of academic and social excellence synonymous with Boggs Academy College Preparatory School. Recipients of BANAS are encouraged to volunteer any available time they may have

during their summer vacation and to give back by supporting the association's scholarship fund upon completion of their studies.
